ABOUT SONNIA L. RIVAS-CABALLERO

Sonnia L. Rivas-Caballero is a pianist, mezzosoprano and musicologist. She has sought in the popular repertoire of the XVI century, melodies that could agree with the poems of the great mystical figures. This poetic-musical work have been recorded on the following CDS: *Coloquio de Amor* (RTVE-Música, 2003), *Del Corazón Enamorado* (RTVE-Música, 2008) and *Recital Teresiano* (Ed. Espiritualidad, 2014), that have obtained numerous awards and prizes, including a Bravo Award in 2004 and a nomination in the Latin Grammy Awards.

In collaboration with Belen Yuste, she has written several books about Anne of St. Bartholomew, Teresa of Jesus and Maria Sklodowska-Curie.
