Members of the audience are given three-channel headphones and welcomed into the performance space to the sound of Igor Stravinsky's *The Rite of Spring*, one of the leading ballets from the last century, of which Pina Bausch made a historic version in 1975. Several voices can be heard –different ones on each channel. Voices in parallel that diverge and overlap. Spectators play the leading role in a show that is both a game and choreography. The performance is in French.

# ABOUT ROGER BERNAT

Roger Bernat is a Catalan director. He studied painting and architecture, although he did not complete his studies. In 1996, he received the Extraordinary Prize of the Teatre Institute of Barcelona. In 2008, he began to create devices in which the public took the stage and became protagonist. "The spectators go through a device that invites them to obey or conspire and, in any case, to pay with their own bodies and to commit themselves," Bernat states.
