With puppetry and animation, *A Mano* teaches lessons on the value of friendship, love and sympathy guide us to the most important things in life. It tells the story of a small character with a great desire to escape from a shop window and its inhabitants. It is a love story, a story about small failures, a potter's wheel, a cup that breathes, two people with great enthusiasm, a tiny pottery workshop and four hands that play.

Since its release in 2012, *A Mano* has been recognized and acclaimed by critics, theater professionals and audiences. It has received several Spanish and International theater awards such as the Best Show Award at the 2015 *Kuss Festival* (Marburg, Germany), the Award for exceptional and refined mastery in puppetry at the 2015 *Impuls Festival* (Bucharest, Romania), and many others in Europe and Spain (Best Small Format Show at the Spanish Showcase *Feten* 2013.)

ABOUT EL PATIO TEATRO

El Patio Teatro was created in Logroño (Spain) in 2010 by Julian Sáenz-López and Izaksun Fernandez. It was born from a need to share with audiences different stories from everyday life that excite them, or they care about and deeply touch them. Those stories serve them as an excuse to seek out their own language to tell them on stage. This search has driven them to take refuge in objects to alive them in a small format, playing with their own hands, as they do in *A Mano*, their very first creation together, where terracotta, modeling and theatre come together.

Since 2013 the company has performed in the more relevant Spanish festivals and theatres and has shared their work with audiences of the 5 continents: Europe, America, Africa, Asia and Australia.
