It presents a unique networking opportunity through which they can meet researchers from their current regions to advance their careers and explore opportunities to collaborate.

The event is open to all European researchers in North America, as well as current, previous and potential North American (Canada / U.S.) researchers who have or would like to benefit from European research grants to further their careers, representatives from European Embassies, North American universities, industry and partners.
