During six days, from March 20th to the 25th, seventy poets gather to celebrate written poetry and the spoken word in English and French at VERSeFest '18, Ottawa's annual International Festival of Poetry. Built on a mandate of fostering creative crossroads and community, the Festival features English and French poetry of all traditions, styles, and forms. Since 2011, the best local, Canadian, and international poets have performed in both spoken and written word genres. As one of Canada's largest and most successful poetry festivals, its stages have featured readings by Griffin, Governor General, and Pulitzer Prize winners.

Berta García Faet is the author of 6 poetry collections, most recently, *Los salmos fosforitos* (2017) and *La edad de merecer* (2015).
