Alice and the Invisible Cities is a free-form version of Alice in Wonderland with a trans-disciplinary staging (projections, sound space, masks and puppets) that explores the imaginary created by Lewis Carroll from a contemporary perspective.

Jesús Nieto, under the name of Onírica Mecánica, builds poetic-mechanical-imaginary worlds for all those in love with the extraordinary. His pieces deal deeply with recent memory and our relation with technology. For 10 years he has been researching on different proposals for family audiences and adults, paying special attention to the interests, concerns and contemporary languages of nowadays teenagers.

He alternates acting with his work as a puppet-master at the Javier Aranda Company, where he carries out personal research on the hand puppet and its relationship with the puppeteer.
