On this international tour, the Royal Opera of Madrid presents a program featuring established Flamenco artists and young promises, reaffirming the institution's dedication to promoting and safeguarding the Flamenco legacy, emphasizing its three core disciplines of singing, guitar playing, and dancing.

ÁNGELES GABALDÓN

Born in Seville in 1974, Gabaldón is a distinguished flamenco dancer known for her dynamic fusion of traditional and contemporary styles. Trained under renowned flamenco masters, she has received multiple national awards recognizing her contributions to the art form. Her career includes performances at prestigious venues such as the *Bienal de Flamenco de Sevilla* and the Metropolitan Opera in New York. Through her work, Ángeles Gabaldón integrates technical precision with expressive depth, offering performances that reflect both the heritage and evolving nature of flamenco.
